NDT Young Creatives⁽⁸⁺⁾

Children aged 8 to 16 take on the role of dancers and makers during this workshop. They get to learn about the creative process, work with NDT's repertory, and discover how to tell your own story through dance. Experience in dance is not necessary!

Free program

There is plenty to see and do in Amare during the *BIG BANG Festival*, even without buying tickets! For example, throughout the day you can do handicraft activities and you can dance in the silent disco on the Kunstenplein^(ALL). And you might just run into several music artists at unexpected times and locations in Amare: La Maquina, But What About and Luciano Gelati. Everyone is welcome to come and go as they please.

Hoppeslot⁽⁵⁺⁾

Dare to take a rhythmic jump on the snow-white *Hoppeslot*; the one and only *BIG BANG* bouncy castle!

Music Playground^(ALL) Tutti Timbri

The playground features instruments of all sizes, designed for both big and small kids. Children can drum, roll, spin, slide, jingle, rattle, and more!

Long Low Slow Baden⁽⁵⁺⁾ Gemma Luz Bosch

An acoustic, immersive installation wherein the audience is one by one invited to lay down on an inflatable.

Dr. MindFlip's Reverie Garden^(ALL) i.s.m. Rewire

Reverie Garden is a gamelike interface for creating soundscapes with live coding.



Muziekbeestjes^(ALL) Milu Chen

Muziekbeestjes is an interactive and kinetic sound installation. The work consists out of sculptural instruments and moving elements.

Wiebelende Wereld^(ALL) Ildikó Horváth i.s.m. Rewire

Wiebelende Wereld is a sonic playground where visitors of all ages are invited to discover movement, balance and gravity through the experience of sound and listening.

Hoorbaar Snoorhaar^(ALL) Milu Chen

This funny-looking object is an instrument. It resembles a bit like a headphone. With this, you can hear the structures of the ground. Put it on your head, walk around calmly, and hear a new world of sound!

These Birds are Flying tot he North^(ALL) Serge Verstockt & ChampdAction

This installation consists of 48 caged mechanical birds. They react to each person's voice and express their joy with cheerful chirping.
